

Regional GIS Update

Fall 2008 Update

It has been another successful year for the GIS project, and ORRS staff has already been preparing for projects to come in the new year.

Commencing in the spring of 2009, 27 municipalities will have their orthophotography updated. These new photos will accommodate new expansion by allowing a half mile photo buffer around each municipality. The resolution of the photos will be enhanced as all will be flown at a 1:5000 resolution which is an upgrade from the 1:10,000 that the majority of municipalities currently have. The completion of this project is tentatively set for the Fall of 2009.

As a result of rapid development within municipalities, orthophotography updates are tentatively being scheduled to occur every 4-5 years.

During the summer of 2008, ORRS staff was busy in the field collecting (GPS) playground equipment for member municipalities. Photos of each feature were also taken, giving the user the not only the ability to view the

spatial location, but a current photo linked to the feature.

As ORRS updates title information every two weeks, there is an inevitability that errors will occur. In some cases land titles will provide erroneous names, or in some instances a civic address instead of a mailing address, which in turn is inputted into the database and displayed on the GIS. If an error does appear within a municipality, please contact any GIS staff member and they will do their best to rectify the problem.

For municipalities that wish to have their trailer parks and condos appear on the GIS please contact ORRS so they can create polygons to place on the GIS.

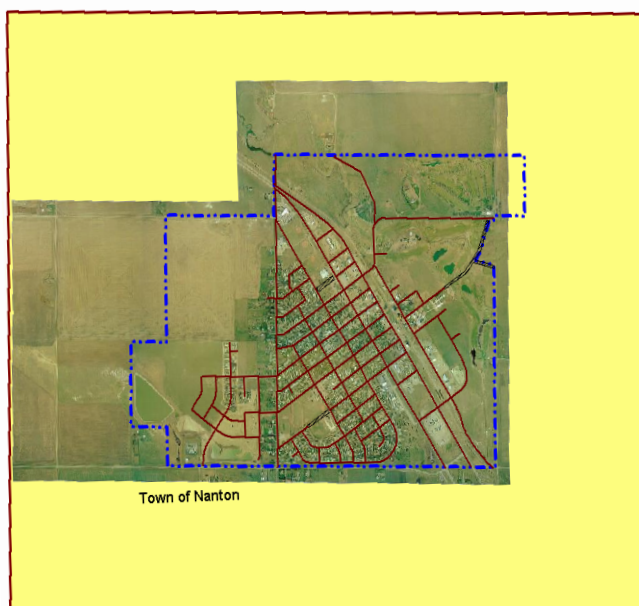
